Uncontrolled bleeding is the second leading cause of death in the United States, after trauma, and more than 6 million bleeding wounds are treated annually by trauma and emergency rooms in the U.S. Unlike absorbent cotton, the combination of glass and bamboo used in the dressing's fibers trigger the body's natural mechanisms for hemorrhage control by rapidly constricting and clotting damaged blood vessels. Wounds become stabilized and blood loss is drastically reduced.

Stasilon® - FR is a wound dressing cleared by the FDA for use by individuals in virtually any environment. No training or special instructions are required. You simply open the package, apply the dressing to the wound and maintain firm pressure.
